# Born of the Seed of Woman

## PROPHECY

"And I will put enmity between you and the woman And between your seed and her seed;  
He shall bruise you on the head, And you shall bruise him on the heel."  
Genesis 3: 15

## FULFILLMENT

"The book of the genealogy of Jesus Christ, the son of David, the son of Abraham."

Matthew 1:1

"Now the promises were spoken to Abraham and to his seed. He does not say, 'And to seeds,' as referring to many, but rather to one, 'And to your seed,' that is, Christ."

Galatians 3: 16

# Born of a Virgin

## Prophecy

" **Isaiah 7:14 (NKJV)** <sup>14</sup> Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a Son, and shall call His name Immanuel.

## Fullfilment

- **Matthew 1:18 (NKJV)** <sup>18</sup> Now the birth of Jesus Christ was as follows: After His mother Mary was betrothed to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Spirit. **Matthew 1:24-25 (NKJV)** <sup>24</sup> Then Joseph, being aroused from sleep, did as the angel of the Lord commanded him and took to him his wife, <sup>25</sup> and did not know her till she had brought forth her firstborn Son. And he called His name Jesus.

# Son of God

## Prophecy

" **Psalm 2:7 (NKJV)** <sup>7</sup> "I will declare the decree: The Lord has said to Me, 'You *are* My Son, Today I have begotten You.

## Fulfillment

• **Matthew 3:17 (NKJV)** <sup>17</sup> And suddenly a voice *came* from heaven, saying, "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased."

# Seed of Abraham

## Prophecy

"<sup>18</sup> In your seed all the nations of the earth shall be blessed, because you have obeyed My voice." **Genesis 22:18 (NKJV)**

## Fulfillment

- <sup>1</sup> The book of the genealogy of Jesus Christ, the Son of David, the Son of Abraham: **Matthew 1:1 (NKJV)**
- <sup>16</sup> Now to Abraham and his Seed were the promises made. He does not say, "And to seeds," as of many, but as of one, "*And to your Seed,*" who is Christ. **Galatians 3:16 (NKJV)**

# Son of Isaac

## Prophecy

"<sup>12</sup> But God said to Abraham, "Do not let it be displeasing in your sight because of the lad or because of your bondwoman. Whatever Sarah has said to you, listen to her voice; for in Isaac your seed shall be called. **Genesis 21:12 (NKJV)**

## Fulfillment

<sup>23</sup> Now Jesus Himself began *His ministry* at about thirty years of age, being . . . The son of Isaac, **Luke 3:23, 34 (NKJV)**

# Son of Jacob

## Prophecy

"<sup>17</sup> "I see Him, but not now; I behold Him, but not near; A Star shall come out of Jacob; A Scepter shall rise out of Israel, And batter the brow of Moab, And destroy all the sons of tumult. **Numbers 24:17 (NKJV)**

## Fulfillment

<sup>23</sup> Now Jesus Himself began *His ministry* at about thirty years of age, being (as was supposed) *the son of . . .the son of Jacob*, **Luke 3:23, 34 (NKJV)**

# House of David

## Prophecy

"<sup>10</sup> The scepter shall not depart from Judah, Nor a lawgiver from between his feet, Until Shiloh comes; And to Him *shall be* the obedience of the people. **Genesis 49:10 (NKJV)**

## Fulfillment

•<sup>23</sup> Now Jesus Himself began *His ministry at* about thirty years of age, being (as was supposed) *the son . . . of David, Luke 3:23, 31 (NKJV)*

# Born in Bethlehem

## Prophecy

"<sup>2</sup> "But you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, *Though* you are little among the thousands of Judah, *Yet* out of you shall come forth to Me The One to be Ruler in Israel, Whose goings forth *are* from of old, From everlasting." **Micah 5:2 (NKJV)**

## Fulfillment

- <sup>1</sup> Now after Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea in the days of Herod the king, behold, wise men from the East came to Jerusalem, **Matthew 2:1 (NKJV)**

# Presented with Gifts

## Prophecy

"<sup>10</sup> The kings of Tarshish and of the isles Will bring presents;  
The kings of Sheba and Seba  
Will offer gifts. **Psalm 72:10**  
**(NKJV)**

## Fulfillment

<sup>1</sup> Now after Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea in the days of Herod the king, behold, wise men from the East came to Jerusalem,<sup>11</sup>  
And when they had come into the house, they saw the young Child with Mary His mother, and fell down and worshiped Him. And when they had opened their treasures, they presented gifts to Him: gold, frankincense, and myrrh. **Matthew 2:1, 11 (NKJV)**

# Herod Kills Children

## Prophecy

"<sup>31:15</sup> Thus says the Lord: "A • voice was heard in Ramah, Lamentation *and* bitter weeping, Rachel weeping for her children, Refusing to be comforted for her children, Because they *are* no more."  
Jeremiah **(NKJV)**

## Fulfillment

<sup>Mt 2:16</sup> Then Herod, when he saw that he was deceived by the wise men, was exceedingly angry; and he sent forth and put to death all the male children who were in Bethlehem and in all its districts, from two years old and under, according to the time which he had determined from the wise men. **(NKJV)**

# Preceded by Messenger

## Prophecy

" <sup>Isa 40:3</sup> The voice of one crying in the wilderness: "Prepare the way of the Lord; Make straight in the desert A highway for our God. **(NKJV)**

## Fulfillment

- <sup>Mt 3:16</sup> When He had been baptized, Jesus came up immediately from the water; and behold, the heavens were opened to Him, and He saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and alighting upon Him. <sup>17</sup> And suddenly a voice *came* from heaven, saying, "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased." **(NKJV)**

# Ministry in Galilee

## Prophecy

" <sup>Isa 9:1</sup> Nevertheless the gloom *will not be* upon her who *is* distressed, As when at first He lightly esteemed The land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali, And afterward more heavily oppressed *her*, *By* the way of the sea, beyond the Jordan, In Galilee of the Gentiles.

## Fulfillment

<sup>Mt 4:12</sup> Now when Jesus heard that John had been put in prison, He departed to Galilee. <sup>13</sup> And leaving Nazareth, He came and dwelt in Capernaum, which is by the sea, in the regions of Zebulun and Naphtali, <sup>Mt 4:17</sup> From that time Jesus began to preach and to say, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."

# Stone of Stumbling to the Jews

## Prophecy

" Ps 118:22 The stone *which* the builders rejected Has become the chief cornerstone.

## Fulfillment

1Pe 2:7 Therefore, to you who believe, *He is* precious; but to those who are disobedient, "*The stone which the builders rejected Has become the chief cornerstone,*"

# He is to Enter the Temple

## Prophecy

" <sup>Mal 3:1</sup> "Behold, I send My messenger, And he will prepare the way before Me. And the Lord, whom you seek, Will suddenly come to His temple, Even the Messenger of the covenant, In whom you delight. Behold, He is coming," Says the Lord of hosts.

## Fulfillment

- <sup>Mt 21:12</sup> Then Jesus went into the temple of God and drove out all those who bought and sold in the temple, and overturned the tables of the money changers and the seats of those who sold doves.

# To Enter Jerusalem on a Donkey

## Prophecy

" <sup>Zec 9:9</sup> "Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout, O daughter of Jerusalem! Behold, your King is coming to you; He *is* just and having salvation, Lowly and riding on a donkey, A colt, the foal of a donkey.

## Fulfillment

- <sup>Lk 19:35</sup> Then they brought him to Jesus. And they threw their own clothes on the colt, and they set Jesus on him. <sup>36</sup> And as He went, *many* spread their clothes on the road. <sup>37</sup> Then, as He was now drawing near the descent of the Mount of Olives, the whole multitude of the disciples began to rejoice and praise God with a loud voice for all the mighty works they had seen,

# Betrayed by a Friend

## Prophecy

“ Ps 41:9 Even my own familiar friend in whom I trusted, Who ate my bread, Has lifted up *his* heel against me.

## Fulfillment

- Mt 10:4 Simon the Cananite, and Judas Iscariot, who also betrayed Him.

# Money Thrown in God's House

## Prophecy

" <sup>Zec 11:13b</sup> So I took the thirty *pieces* of silver and threw them into the house of the Lord for the potter.

## Fulfillment

• <sup>Mt 26:15</sup> and said, "What are you willing to give me if I deliver Him to you?" And they counted out to him thirty pieces of silver.

# Price Given for Potter's Field

## Prophecy

“ Zec 11:13b So I took the thirty *pieces* of silver and threw them into the house of the Lord for the potter.

## Fulfillment

- Mt 27:7 And they consulted together and bought with them the potter's field, to bury strangers in.

# Silent Before His Accusers

## Prophecy

" <sup>Isa 53:7</sup> He was oppressed and He was afflicted, Yet He opened not His mouth; He was led as a lamb to the slaughter, And as a sheep before its shearers is silent, So He opened not His mouth.

## Fulfillment

<sup>Mt 27:12</sup> And while He was being accused by the chief priests and elders, He answered nothing.

# Wounded and Bruised

## Prophecy

" <sup>Isa 53:5</sup> But He *was* wounded for our transgressions, *He was* bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace *was* upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed.

## Fulfillment

- <sup>Mt 27:26</sup> Then he released Barabbas to them; and when he had scourged Jesus, he delivered *Him* to be crucified.

# Smitten and Spit Upon

## Prophecy

" <sup>Isa 50:6</sup> I gave My back •  
to those who struck  
*Me*, And My cheeks to  
those who plucked out  
the beard; I did not  
hide My face from  
shame and spitting.

## Fulfillment

<sup>Mt 26:67</sup> Then they spat  
in His face and beat  
Him; and others  
struck *Him* with the  
palms of their hands,

# Mocked

## Prophecy

" Ps 22:7 All those who see ●  
Me ridicule Me; They  
shoot out the lip, they  
shake the head, *saying*,  
<sup>8</sup> "He trusted in the Lord,  
let Him rescue Him; Let  
Him deliver Him, since He  
delights in Him!"

## Fulfillment

Mt 27:31 And when they  
had mocked Him,  
they took the robe  
off Him, put His *own*  
clothes on Him, and  
led Him away to be  
crucified.

# Fell Under the Cross

## Prophecy

" Ps 109:24 My knees are weak through fasting, And my flesh is feeble from lack of fatness.

<sup>25</sup> I also have become a reproach to them; *When* they look at me, they shake their heads.

## Fulfillment

- Jn 19:17 And He, bearing His cross, went out to a place called *the Place* of a Skull, which is called in Hebrew, Golgotha,
- Lk 23:26 Now as they led Him away, they laid hold of a certain man, Simon a Cyrenian, who was coming from the country, and on him they laid the cross that he might bear *it* after Jesus.

# Hands & Feet Pierced

## Prophecy

" Ps 22:16 For dogs have surrounded Me; The congregation of the wicked has enclosed Me. They pierced My hands and My feet;

## Fulfillment

• Lk 23:33 And when they had come to the place called Calvary, there they crucified Him, and the criminals, one on the right hand and the other on the left.

# Crucified with Thieves

## Prophecy

“ Isa 53:12b Because He poured out His soul unto death, And He was numbered with the transgressors, And He bore the sin of many, And made intercession for the transgressors.

## Fulfillment

- Mt 27:38 Then two robbers were crucified with Him, one on the right and another on the left.

# Made Intercession for Persecutors

## Prophecy

" Isa 53:12 Therefore I will divide Him a portion with the great, And He shall divide the spoil with the strong, Because He poured out His soul unto death, And He was numbered with the transgressors, And He bore the sin of many, And made intercession for the transgressors.

## Fulfillment

- Lk 23:34 Then Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they do." And they divided His garments and cast lots.

# Rejected by His Own People

## Prophecy

“ <sup>Isa 53:3</sup> He is despised and rejected by men, A Man of sorrows and acquainted with grief. And we hid, as it were, *our* faces from Him; He was despised, and we did not esteem Him.

## Fulfillment

• <sup>Jn 7:5</sup> For even His brothers did not believe in Him. <sup>Jn 7:48</sup> Have any of the rulers or the Pharisees believed in Him?

# Hated Without a Cause

## Prophecy

“ Ps 69:4 Those who hate me without a cause Are more than the hairs of my head;

## Fulfillment

Jn 15:25 But *this happened* that the word might be fulfilled which is written in their law, '*They hated Me without a cause.*'

# People Shook Their Heads

## Prophecy

“ Ps 109:25 I also have become a reproach to them; *When* they look at me, they shake their heads.

## Fulfillment

- Mt 27:39 And those who passed by blasphemed Him, wagging their heads

# Garments Parted and Lots Cast

## Prophecy

" Ps 22:18 They divide  
My garments among  
them, And for My  
clothing they cast lots.

## Fulfillment

- Jn 19:23 Then the soldiers . . .  
took His garments and made  
four parts, to each soldier a  
part, and also the tunic. Now  
the tunic was without seam,  
woven from the top in one  
piece. <sup>24</sup> They said therefore  
among themselves, "Let us  
not tear it, but cast lots for  
it, whose it shall be,"

# To Suffer Thirst

## Prophecy

" Ps 69:21 They also gave  
me gall for my food,  
And for my thirst they  
gave me vinegar to  
drink.

## Fulfillment

Jn 19:28 After this, Jesus,  
knowing that all  
things were now  
accomplished, that  
the Scripture might  
be fulfilled, said, "I  
thirst!"

# His Forsaken Cry

## Prophecy

" Ps 22:1 My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me? *Why are You so far from helping Me, And from the words of My groaning?*

## Fulfillment

- Mt 27:46 And about the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, "Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani?" that is, "*My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?*"

# Committed Himself to God

## Prophecy

" Ps 31:5 Into Your hand I  
commit my spirit;

## Fulfillment

Lk 23:46 And when Jesus  
had cried out with a  
loud voice, He said,  
"Father, *'into Your  
hands I commit My  
spirit.'*"

# Bones Not Broken

## Prophecy

“ Ps 34:20 He guards all his bones; Not one of them is broken.

## Fulfillment

• Jn 19:33 But when they came to Jesus and saw that He was already dead, they did not break His legs.

# Heart Broken

## Prophecy

“ Ps 22:14 I am poured out like water, And all My bones are out of joint; My heart is like wax; It has melted within Me.

## Fulfillment

- Jn 19:34 But one of the soldiers pierced His side with a spear, and immediately blood and water came out.

# His Side Pierced

## Prophecy

“ Zec 12:10 “They will look on Me whom they pierced. Yes, they will mourn for Him as one mourns for *his* only *son*, and grieve for Him as one grieves for a firstborn.

## Fulfillment

- Jn 19:34 But one of the soldiers pierced His side with a spear, and immediately blood and water came out.

# Darkness Over the Land

## Prophecy

" Am 8:9 "And it shall come to pass in that day," says the Lord God, "That I will make the sun go down at noon, And I will darken the earth in broad daylight;

## Fulfillment

- Mt 27:45 Now from the sixth hour until the ninth hour there was darkness over all the land.

# Buried in Rich Man's Tomb

## Prophecy

“ Isa 53:9 And they made  
His grave with the  
wicked-- But with the  
rich at His death,  
Because He had done  
no violence, Nor *was*  
*any* deceit in His  
mouth.

## Fulfillment

Mt 27:57 . . . there came a  
rich man from  
Arimathea, named  
Joseph . . . and asked for  
the body of Jesus. . . <sup>59</sup>  
When Joseph had taken  
the body, he wrapped it  
in a clean linen cloth, <sup>60</sup>  
and laid it in his new  
tomb

# His Resurrection

" Ps 16:8 I have set the Lord always before me; Because *He* is at my right hand I shall not be moved. <sup>9</sup> Therefore my heart is glad, and my glory rejoices; My flesh also will rest in hope.

<sup>10</sup> For You will not leave my soul in Sheol, Nor will You allow Your Holy One to see corruption.

" Ps 30:3 O Lord, You brought my soul up from the grave; You have kept me alive, that I should not go down to the pit.

" Ps 118:17 I shall not die, but live, And declare the works of the Lord.

" Hos 6:2 After two days He will revive us; On the third day He will raise us up, That we may live in His sight.

# His Ascension

" Ps 16:11 You will show me the path of life; In Your presence *is* fullness of joy; At Your right hand *are* pleasures forevermore.

" Ps 24:7 Lift up your heads, O you gates! And be lifted up, you everlasting doors! And the King of glory shall come in.

" Ps 68:18 You have ascended on high, You have led captivity captive; You have received gifts among men, Even *from* the rebellious, That the Lord God might dwell *there*.

" Ps 110:1 The Lord said to my Lord, "Sit at My right hand, Till I make Your enemies Your footstool."

# His Return

- <sup>Isa 9:6</sup> For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a Son is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. <sup>7</sup> Of the increase of *His* government and peace *There will be* no end, Upon the throne of David and over His kingdom, To order it and establish it with judgment and justice From that time forward, even forever. The zeal of the Lord of hosts will perform this.

# His Return

- Da 7:13 "I was watching in the night visions, And behold, *One* like the Son of Man, Coming with the clouds of heaven! He came to the Ancient of Days, And they brought Him near before Him. <sup>14</sup> Then to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, That all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion *is* an everlasting dominion, Which shall not pass away, And His kingdom *the one* Which shall not be destroyed.
