3 Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself. 4 Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others.

The covenant we use is in the cover of each hymnal.

But those are words.

What is a church? What did Jesus mean to do when He gave us the church?

What did Paul intend when he establish churches everywhere he had converts on his missionary journeys?

The world has seen the benefits of the church and have borrowed heavily from it.

Support groups.

Group counseling.

Benefits to help people.

And as the world has borrowed from the church, the church have given up those things.
